Finding a doctor



Your plan uses a multi-tier provider network to ensure maximum access to providers for all members. Your network is named “UO Student Health Plan.”

The University Health Services and University Counseling Services are considered in-network providers for your plan. When you use these facilities, there will be no cost to you. To learn more about these services, visit Health.UOoregon.edu.

The University of Oregon has directly contracted with some providers to create a UO Exclusive provider network in the Eugene-Springfield area. When seeing a provider in this network, you will pay less.

You also have access to in-network doctors throughout Oregon, Washington, Idaho, and Montana. When seeing these providers, your costs will be slightly higher. If you get care from a provider or facility that is not contracted with either the University of Oregon or PacificSource, these are considered out-of-network providers and will cost the most. To search for in-network providers, visit ProviderDirectory.PacificSource.com. Choose “UO Student Health Plan” in the Plan or Network field.

You can search by specialty, last name, location, or other details to access a list of providers. Or you can create your own personalized provider directory to download and print.

If you live or are traveling outside Idaho, Montana, Oregon, or Washington, you can get in-network care through our collaboration with Aetna Signature Administrators®. Search their network of more than 1.9 million providers at Aetna.com/ASA.

Dental plans

The University Health Services Dental Clinic is an in-network provider for your plan. Your out-of-pocket costs are lowest when seeking care at this clinic. To learn more, visit Health.UOoregon.edu/Dental.

The University of Oregon has also contracted directly with dentists in the Eugene-Springfield area.

When you see these dentists, you’ll pay your plan’s copay, deductible, and/or coinsurance at the in-network level.

Note: Not all students are eligible for dental benefits. Please confirm your eligibility before accessing services.

Prescriptions and pharmacies



Your plan offers multiple tiers of prescription benefits. The University Health Services Pharmacy is an in-network provider for your plan. For the best benefit (lowest copay), use this pharmacy whenever possible.

PacificSource drug lists

The PacificSource drug lists identify medications that can provide the best results at the lowest cost. Your health plan uses the Oregon drug list.

Mail-order prescriptions

Submitting a claim



Usually, your provider will submit claims for you. If you need to fill a covered prescription or see a provider for a covered service and don't have your ID card, or if you see an out-of-network provider, you can pay and then submit a copy of the provider's itemized receipt or statement for reimbursement.
